□ **Negotiations Update** (40 minutes; Stakes and Hoffman)

- CMC and Longevity MOUs An MOU to get additional compensation and protection for those who work at CMC was approved. Longevity settlement assures that no faculty member will wait for longevity step 16 longer than three years.
- o Increase to fringe request The EB decided that fringe should cover at least the out of pocket cost for the single employee. If we increase fringe by \$60 for FT and 30 to Pt it would just barely cover it. We will also work to get increases covered in future years. We did ask for tiered fringe in the past. District would not agree to that but they did agree to the insurance pool. We are one of very few community colleges that don't pay insurance for two party or family rate. The costs for our single plan is about comparable to other districts. We will look at the possibility of tiered fringe again.
- Current step and column schedules

 B2 is about 61.2% of B1. Our part time salary schedule has 14 steps. There are no longevity steps for part-timers. B3 is 75% of B2. B4 is 2/3 of the lab rate. There was discussion about lab rates and program leads. A start for full time leads is to survey other colleges. Our division chairs are paid higher than most. There are some schools where lab and lecture rate are the same but they also have "Activity" Schedules.

- Percentage relationship of four salary schedules We are looking at strategies to better align B1 and B2.
- AB 1690—new section 87482.3 to Ed code requires seniority rights ranking for PT faculty that would be used for any schedule reduction; will need to write into Article 5
- Do we want to participate in assessment of other colleges to use for comparable institutions list? (FYI - Meetings are about to get underway initiated by Classified Union, CCCUE)
