CCFT Senate Council Report January 28, 2022

- 1. CCFT is working with the administration to make improvements to the new and yet to be fully implemented key policy. We understand there are significant concerns about the policy, especially related to PT faculty.
- 2. CCFT is in the process of revising the division chair evaluation form. Please see your divisional CCFT rep to provide feedback.
- 3. CCFT worked with the district to extend the temporary remote teaching/service policy for Spring '22 classes scheduled f2f for up to an additional 2 weeks. This is an optional extension, up to the individual faculty. Be sure to notify your chair, dean, and students of your decision for the next two weeks.
- 4. We are in discussions with the district to ensure that masks are available in each classroom and for faculty to have the choice to require students wear surgical masks in lieu of fabric face coverings while in classrooms or in personal offices. [*this didn't go as planned, and we can't require surgical masks*]
- 5. There will be an election for CCFT President this term. Please look for a nomination announcement from our election committee soon.
- 6. Membership drive: CCFT members who <u>recruit a new member</u> earn \$10, so does the new member. And the recruiter is put into a \$250 drawing! <u>Membership form</u>.
