- 3. **CCFT is hoping to commence negotiations** in mid-November for our new contract that would start July 1, 2023. Highlights of our goals relate to PT parity, PT health care, lab/lecture parity, and retiree health benefits.
- 4. **Compressed calendar task force:** CCFT and the district have formed a joint task force (with a Senate rep) to develop information and a proposal for moving to a compressed calendar. It seems important to discuss now that Cal Poly is moving to a 16-week term in fall 2026 and that we're competing for students in the online space for DE classes.
