

CCFT report to the Senate Council 2/25/2022

1. In 2022, CCFT has funded its endowed Future Teacher scholarship through the Cuesta College Foundation. The scholarship will support a student with approximately \$1,000 annually. We also funded the scholarship for this year with a separate donation. Our treasurer, Elizabeth Lobo, was an awesome proponent and facilitator for making this happen. Thank you Elizabeth!
2. CCFT hosted a membership drive social last week. Ideas discussed at the event ranged from the prospect of PT faculty being allowed (and compensated?) for evaluating other PT faculty, improving mentoring and orientation materials for PT faculty, and having Flex and social activities designed for people who teach PT. You can tell we had a lot of PT faculty in attendance.
